Description of the Instrument

- The survey was used to determine the knowledge of parents of children under age 10 on prevention of burn, automobile injury and poisoning.
- The survey is composed of 10 questions.

Form of instrument:

- Questionnaire/ Survey
- Injury Surveillance/Tracking tool

Method of delivery:

- Self-Report
- Mail-out

Relevance to injury/ Percentage of the instrument specific to injury

- To assess the parents' knowledge on how to prevent burns, automobile injuries and poisoning.

- Qualitative

Setting/sample instrument used in:

- The New York State Health Department mailed the survey to its 29 child restraint loaner projects. The 29 project coordinators then asked one parent per family to answer the survey.
